311 is a convenient, quick way to report non-emergency issues by submitting a report on the website or mobile app, or by **calling 311**. You can report issues with animals, traffic signs, potholes, graffiti, code enforcement, traffic engineering, and much more. *Contamos con personal bilingue*.

If your item doesn't fit in one of the trash bins you must call to have Solid Waste pick it up. There is **NO FEE** for this service and you can call for any address in Azalea Park. You will only need to provide the address and the item that needs to be picked up.

LIHEAP is a federally-funded program, providing financial assistance to low-income households in meeting the costs of home heating and cooling for Orange County residents. LIHEAP offers a yearly home energy credit to help eligible households in meeting the cost of home energy. LIHEAP phone lines are open from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. five days per week. Appointments are scheduled over the telephone by calling (407-836-7429)
