

South Goldenrod Safe Neighborhood Association Meeting Minutes

January 19, 2017

President Blackman called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.

Welcome and introduction of officers noting that Secretary Sonia Viera was absent.

The scheduled speaker was unable to attend; however, he will be speaking at the meeting in February.

O C Deputies - Sgt. Charles Denmark introduced both Deputy Sean Wasco and Deputy Forrest Best. Deputy Best is the new Crime Prevention Officer for Sector 2. Deputy Best provided some background information indicating also that he patrolled the area for 3 years prior to becoming Crime Prevention. He advised that Sector 2 is 400 Square miles and there are 4,400 residents. He spoke about some of the issues occurring in the neighborhoods noting that breaking into cars is happening throughout Orange County. The tips given, remove all valuables, make sure to lock the car, try to park in a lit area, and don't leave the car running. He reported that the Gun Buy Back program will take place on 2/9/17. The issue of the letters on the reader board signs was discussed. President Blackman showed white 2" stencil letters that were purchased. The issue is how they can be attached to the inside of the reader board since it is made of some sort of material. Some

suggestions were measure the inside and cut a board to fit, putting a piece of wood on the outside, top or bottom of the reader board. It remains a problem since the letters are not durable and there are not enough letters to post all the necessary information. With regards to the entryway sign for Quail Hollow at Rio Pinar, there is a bit of internal conflict within Orange Counting surrounding the permitting. Jason Reynolds will look into the situation for us. Residents were reminded that Commissioner Clarke is at the Chickasaw Library every 2nd Wednesday of the month from 10:00 am till 2:00 pm.
