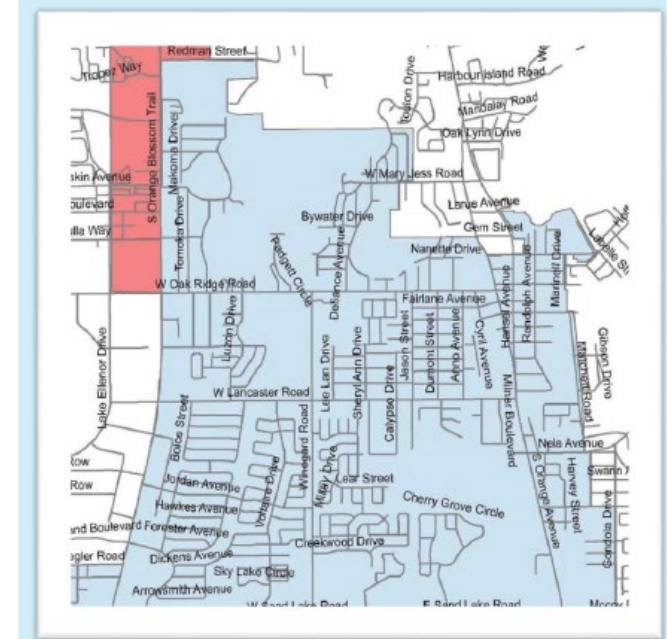
Dear Neighbors,

**THE CRAWFORD HOUSE** is one of the few remaining connections to the farmers, ranchers, dairy men, and grove owners who populated the area in Central Florida's early days. It is best known as the home of Miss Essie Crawford, one of the most beloved teachers at the old Pine Castle School. In Miss Essie's time, the Crawford house's spacious front porch was a favorite gathering spot for students and parents alike. Efforts to save the Crawford house date back to the 1980's.
