Learn to recognize fraud and how to avoid becoming a victim. Orange County's Consumer Protection Office is on your side to provide the information you need and protection you deserve. A few suggestions:

GETTING YOUR CAR REPAIRED

- Get a written estimate that itemizes all parts and labor you are paying for.
- Seek a second opinion for any major repair work.
- Make sure you get a copy of the warranty.

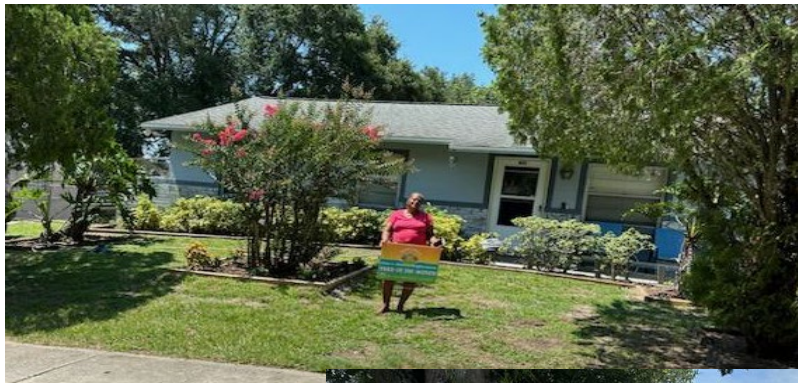
TELEPHONE SOLICITATIONS

- Ask the caller to send you the information via regular mail.
- Never give a telemarketer your credit card number unless you trust them.

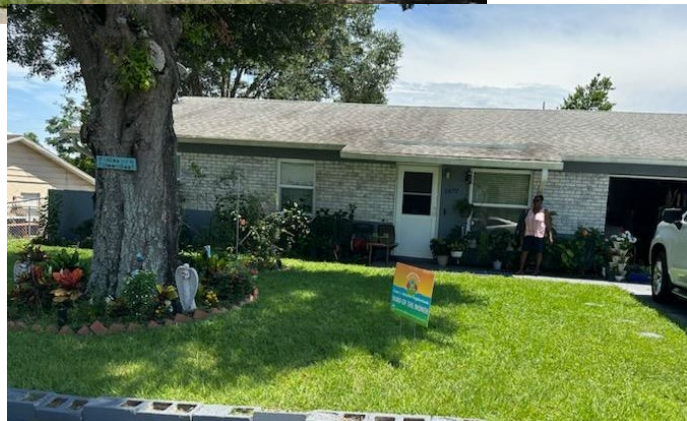

Q. I noticed a streetlight on my street isn't working. Who do I call to fix it?

A. Make sure to call for repair if a streetlight isn't working or is blinking. Contact your local utility company, **Duke Energy**, at **800-700-8744**, or www.duke-energy.com/customer-service/request-light-repair.
