When recovering from or preparing for a hurricane, hire a licensed contractor.

- Avoid door-to-door solicitors.
- Insist on references, a proper license, bonding and insurance.
- Check out credentials.
 - Orange County licensed contractors at www.fasttrack.ocfl.net (click on licensed contractors).
 - Verify licenses with the State of Florida at www.myfloridalicense.com.
- Make sure the contract can be broken if you don't receive financing.
- Hire a contractor with a real office, not just a post office box address.
