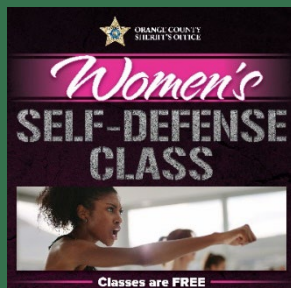


Code Compliance Question & Answer

Q: Code Compliance says junk vehicles are not allowed. **What constitutes a junk vehicle?**

A: Flat tires, undergrowth, dismantled, wrecked, no license plate, expired tag or **registration**. After a code violation notice is issued, if owners do not remove or repair the vehicle in 15 days, the County contractor can tow it away.
