### Code Compliance Question & Answer

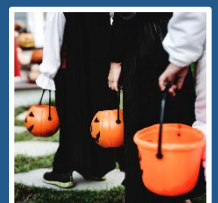
**Q:** How do I make a complaint and have Code Compliance investigate?

**A:** Call 407-836-3111 ("3-1-1"). Describe the situation you observe and provide an address. It's best to specify if the violation is more likely to occur at certain times of the day or during the week. The County also has a 3-1-1 mobile app on which you can report code compliance issues. You can scan the QR codes to find the app.



### Halloween Safety

- **NEVER** trick-or-treat alone! A responsible adult or teen should accompany each group of four to five.
- Try to trick-or-treat when there is still light outside.
- Children should not run while trick-or-treating and **NEVER** run between parked cars.
- Only cross the street at the corner (after looking **BOTH** ways).
- If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic.
- Stay in your own neighborhood and only go to houses that have their porch lights on.
- Know exactly what route your child(ren) are taking.
- **NEVER** enter a stranger's home, even if invited.
- Carry trick-or-treat bags that have handles to keep arms free.

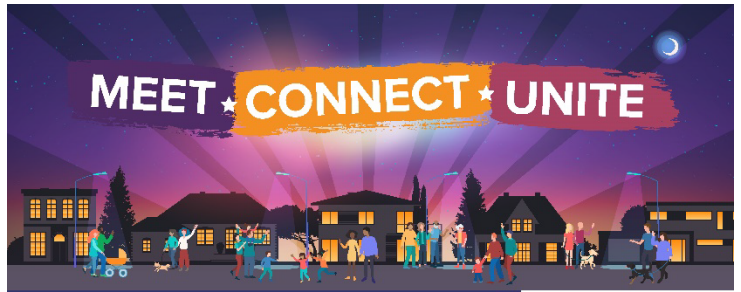
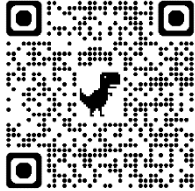
