

Chicken Tenders?

Orange County adopted Ordinance 2021-34 allowing chickens to be kept on properties zoned for and developed with detached single-family residences **with a permit**. YES, PERMITS are REQUIRED, for which there is a FEE. Also, you must take a course from the University of Florida Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences (UF/IFAS) Extension (Orange County Backyard Chicken Training Class). Go to www.ocfl.net and search for **residential backyard chicken permit** or call the Zoning Division at 407-836-3111 for more information.

It's a Sidewalk

Yes, the paved areas along rights-of-way are for pedestrians, joggers and bicyclists. They are never intended nor designed for heavy vehicles such as cars, pickup trucks, work trucks, or semis (tractor-trailers). Florida Statutes Chapter 316, State Uniform Traffic Control lists what is prohibited on sidewalks. Keep in mind OUR tax dollars pay for the costs of these necessary sidewalks, which are public infrastructure. They were NEVER intended to be driven or parked on. Let us set a good example for all our residents, young and old, and use common sense to avoid damaging our sidewalks because of heavy vehicles.
